Pay Scale :- Rs.5500-175-9000 + Dearness Allowance, House Rent Allowance, City Allowance, Transport Allowance etc. as per prevailing Govt. resolution.

Minimum Educational Qualification :-

As per Govt.Resolution DCM 1089/2148/का सेवा ३ Dt. 25.4.1990 candidate should have passed the examination conducted by Maharashtra State Technical Education Board for three year diploma course in any one engineering faculty of Mechanical Engineering/ Automobile Engineering/ Production Engineering / Production Technology)

Age limit :-

- 1) As on 1 / 3 / 2009. minimum 18 yrs .and maximum 33 yrs. For reserve class candidates maximum upper age limit is 38 yrs.
- 2) **Post reserved for Physically handicapped candidates are already filled, hence no reservation for Physically handicapped is available.**
- 3) **As per Govt. General Administration Circular No. Marathi एसआरव्ही-१०९७/प्र.क्र.३१/१८/१६-अ dated 16/3/1999 reservation for Ex-servicemen is applicable only for Group C & D category . As the post Post of Junior Engineer (Mech) is Grade-B (Non gazetted) post so there is no reservation applicable For Ex-military person however upper age limit will be relaxed as per existing Govt.rules.**

Important Notice :-

- 1) Candidate should be resident of Maharashtra It is necessary to submit Domicile Certificate along with application
- 2) This advertisement is available on Govt.Of Maharashtra web site www.maharashtra.gov.in and on Chief Engineer (Mech.) Water Resources Department Nashiks web site www.mahayantriki.gov.in
- 3) As per Maharashtra Government – General Administrative Department Resolution No. Prashikshan 2000/P.K.61/2001/39 dated. 19.3.2003 candidates applying for above post should submit certificate regarding passing any one examination of Computer handling / using D.O.E.A.C.C. C.C.C. level or ‘ O ‘ level or ‘ A ‘ level or ‘ B ‘ level or ‘ C ‘ level or Maharashtra State Higher Technical Board MS CIT examination within two years from the date of appointment or other wise his services will be discontinued

If candidate is having certificate Of passing any one examination mentioned above it should be submitted along with application form.

- 4) Women’s reservation is applicable as per Govt.Resolution women and child welfare department No.82/2001 मसेआ 2000/P.K. 415/का- 2 dated 25.5.2001.
- 5) **Reservation for sports man is kept As per Govt. Resolutions No.(Marathi) राक्रीधो-२००२/प्र.क्र.६८/ क्रियुसे-२ dated 30.4.2005 which is 5%**
- 6) Candidates selected for the post of Jr.Engr (Mech) is required to pass Lower Grade Hindi & Higher Grade Marathi Examination as per prevailing Govt. rules.
- 7) As per Govt.Directives candidate selected for this post is required to pass professional examination in three consecutive chances.

8) Candidates selected for this post are eligible to be transferred any where in Maharashtra State.

Note :-

1) It is necessary to submit certified copies of Educational qualification Proof of Date of birth, Caste Certificate in case of reserve category candidates alongwith the application form. It is compulsory to submit Original copies of these certificates at the time of oral examination.

2) Candidates from reserve class categories should submit their caste validity certificate along with application. If validity certificate is not submitted by the selected candidate within time period stipulated as per Govt.rules then appointment on that post will not be given to the such candidate and preference to other eligible candidate will be given..

3) After scrutiny of applications objective written test of 175 marks will be taken among eligible candidates. There after the Qualified candidates in written test will have to appear for the oral test of 25 marks conducted by the committee formed by office of the Chief Engineer (Mech)

Candidates appearing for written & oral test will have to bear traveling expenses by their own.

4) Syllabus for Written & Oral test will be as under

a) All engineering subjects covered during the Mechanical Engineering/ Automobile Engineering/Production Engineering /Production Technology Diploma three years course

b) Syllabus covered for the MS-CIT course of M.S.higher Tech. Education Board, Mumbai

c) General Knowledge

5) Maharashtra State Public Services (Reservation for scheduled Casts, Scheduled tribes, Denotified Tribes (Vimukta Jatis), Nomadic Tribes special backward category and other Backward classes) Act-2001 (Mah.Act.VIII of 2004) is implemented by Govt.of Maharashtra since 29 th January 2004. As per Rule No.4 (2)(Two) subsection principle of elevated & progressed group (creamy layer) is applicable to all categories except scheduled cast and scheduled tribes. Hence the principle of elevated & progressed group (creamy layer) is applicable to “ V.J. (A) ‘ N.T.(B) ‘ N.T.(C) ‘ NTCD’ ‘SBC’ and O.B.C. Orders for implementing this is issued by Government social justice cultural affair special assistance department Circular NO.CBC-10/2006/P.K.15/BCC.5 dated 30 June 2006 with prescribed modified format for classification. Candidates belonging to these categories should submit

certificate in the format that they are not belonging to elevated and progressed group (Non creamy layer) This Govt. circular & format is available on Maharashtra Government website www.maharashtra.gov.in under computer code 20060710122458001. It is necessary to submit the Non creamy layer certificate having validity up to 31/3/2008 along with application form, or otherwise the application will be considered from open category.

6) 30% reservation of women's is not applicable to open category women belonging to elevated & progressed families (creamy layer). Similarly 30 % women's reservation except Scheduled Cast & Scheduled tribes is not applicable to women's of Backward class i.e. " V.J. (A) ' 'N.T.(B)' 'N.T.(C)' ' NT(D)' 'SBC' and O.B.C and who are belonging to elevated & progressed families (creamy layer).

7) Govt. has prescribed small family affidavit for recruitment to the posts of Group 'A' 'B' 'C' & 'D' as a necessary Qualification as "Maharashtra Public Service (small family affidavit) rule 2005" vide notification dated 28 March 2005. This advertisement is published in accordance with these rules. Affidavit नमुना - अ is available on website <http://oasis.mkcl.org/mech> It is compulsory to submit this affidavit alongwith the application.

8) As per Govt. resolution No. अनियो-१००५/१२६/सेवा-४ dated 31st October 2005 New Pension Scheme is applicable to the employees entering in Govt. Service after 1.11.2005.

9) All rights are reserved by Chief Engineer (Mechanical) Water resources Department, Nasik-2. regarding Type of examination / No. of Posts / Partial change in parallel reservation, staying, canceling or postponing examinations.

10) If it is found that false information is given with application form or forged documents are submitted with the application, candidates candidature or his appointment will be cancelled at any stage of recruitment.

11) Candidate should gives choice of three examination Centers from Nagpur / Amarawati / Nashik / Mumbai / Pune / Aurangabad / Nanded / Kolhapur in order of preference. Once the preference is given it should not be changed which may please be noted. As per candidates available Maharashtra Knowledge Corporation Ltd., Pune will fix the examination centers within candidates choice.

12) Employees in Govt. Service should inform their controlling officers while applying for the post of Junior Engineer (Mechanical). They should also inform the Controlling officer that, if there is any objection it should be informed to Chief Engineer (Mechanical) Water resources department Nasik within a month. Copy of letter given to controlling officer should be submitted with application.

13) Last date of filling the application on website is **04 / 03 / 2009** After filling application on website its printout should be taken and after affixing Photo, enclosing necessary documents & Demand Draft of prescribed amount the application should be sent to MKCL Pune so as to reach the same on or before by .12 / 3 / 2009. up to 17.00 hrs.

Applications received after this date & time will not be accepted.

14) Admit card of written examination will be sent to eligible candidates up to 15 / 4 / 2009 mentioning the Date, Time, Location & Centre of examination on admit card. Candidates not receiving the admit card by 15 / 4 / 2009 should contact MKCL Pune & obtain their admit cards. In any case candidates will not be allowed to give examination without authorized admit card.

Procedure for applying :-

- 1) Prescribed application form will available on website <http://oasis.mkcl.org/mech>. from 12 / 02 / 2009
- 2) After filling the application on website candidate should take out its Printout. On this printout candidate should affix his passport size photo & his signature should be done in the box below his photo.
- 3) The copies of certificates which are to be attached with the application should be got attested from Gazetted officer or competent authority.
- 4) Candidate should enclose self addressed envelope of size 25 cm x 12 cm with postage stamps of Rs. 10/- (Rs. Ten only) dully affixed.
- 5) Demand Draft of Rs.300/- (Rs. Three Hundred only.) in case of open category candidates and of Rs.150/- (Rs. One Hundred Fifty only.) for backward class category candidates, of any Nationalized bank drawn in favour of Maharashtra Knowledge Corporation Ltd; Pune, & payable at Pune should be enclosed with the application form.
